## **Waterline replacement project starts tonight on Route 4**

**Fairfield, OH** – Work is scheduled to begin at 8 p.m. this evening near Nilles Road on Route 4 with the waterline replacement project that is a significant part of the City's Capital Improvement Program.

The work will be done by Howell Contractors and is scheduled to be complete by late Fall of this year. To minimize disruption to traffic, work will be done in the evening and overnight from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. The project will replace and upgrade existing waterline between Bypass 4 and Nilles Road.

This work is scheduled to be completed ahead of next year's paving project. Paving of Route 4 is scheduled for Summer of 2018 from Seward Road to north of the railroad overpass (just south of Bobmeyer Road in Hamilton.)
