City of Fairfield’s new app ready for download

Fairfield, Ohio – The City’s new app called “Fairfield on the Go” that will connect residents with services and resources on mobile devices is launched and ready for download.

“Use *Fairfield on the Go* wherever you are to buy tickets for Community Arts Center performances, find out about City jobs, report a concern, and much more,” said Assistant City Manager Greg Preece. “It coincides with our new website that went live a few months ago. These tools are part of ongoing work in several ways throughout the City to provide digital options that help us better serve residents.”
