## **North Gilmore Road Construction Set to Begin**

**Fairfield, OH** – Motorists are advised that construction on North Gilmore Road from Holden to Symmes is scheduled to begin as soon as school lets out for the summer at the end of this week.

Mobilization and preliminary work will take place this week with minimal disruption to traffic. After June 7, North Gilmore Road will be closed to through traffic. Local traffic will be able to access their properties within the work zone in the northbound direction only.

The work being performed is by the Eagle Bridge Company, under contract with the City of Fairfield, to make improvements to North Gilmore Road. Improvements include the widening of North Gilmore to a three lane roadway between Holden and Busway, making grade improvements at the railroad tracks, and adding paved shoulder to the two lane section between the railroad tracks and Symmes Road.

Prior to the closure, portable electronic message boards will be posted to communicate the upcoming changes to traffic patterns. A detour will be posted directing traffic around the construction site via Symmes Road to Bilstein Boulevard / Holden Boulevard.
