Fairfield Forward: Shaping the City's Future

Fairfield, OH – The Development Services Department is starting what will be a year-long journey of collaboration with the community to update the City's comprehensive plan. This initiative is called *Fairfield Forward*.

The comprehensive plan provides a framework for future development and redevelopment of the City. It addresses issues of land use, transportation, economic development, housing and other quality of life factors for residents as well as those who visit or work in Fairfield.

"This will be a collaborative process involving all members of the community, including residents, business owners, City officials and other key stakeholders who want to see Fairfield move in the right direction," said Planning Manager Erin Lynn. "A vigorous selection process was conducted in the spring to select a consultant – Jacobs Engineering – to help guide the update process."
