“Respect 101” marks start of City’s diversity initiative

Fairfield, OH – Leaders from The University of Cincinnati (UC) Division of Equity, Inclusion & Community Impact delivered a half-day workshop for 73 supervisory staff across all City departments on Thursday, January 31, 2019.

UC Facilitators, **Matt Olovson** and Dr. **Dy'an Marinos**, presented "Respect 101," which was a half-day session touching on anti-harassment, non-discrimination, diversity, equity, and inclusion. This training marked the start of a greater diversity management and recruitment effort on the part of the City.

During the sessions, supervisors, managers and directors learned about preventing and identifying harassment, understanding diversity, and creating an inclusive work environment for employees and the public. They also took part in several group exercises.
