

REGULATIONS FOR ROADWAY CLOSINGS FOR BLOCK PARTIES

1. Applicant must be at least twenty-one (21) years of age and a resident of the street to be utilized.
2. Applicant must be available to receive delivery of barricades from the Street Division.
3. Applicant is responsible for removal of the barricades from the roadway at the end of the block party.
4. Applicant must submit a petition of agreement with signatures of 95% of the residents who live on the street to be closed.
5. Permit is good for one (1) day only.
6. Vehicular access for area residents must be maintained to provide ingress and egress to properties.
7. Pavement must remain clear of obstructions to provide access for emergency vehicles.
8. Block parties must end by 11:00 p.m.
9. Application must be submitted in person to the Director of Public Works, 8870 N. Gilmore Road, Fairfield, Ohio, three (3) weeks prior to the proposed block party.
10. No block parties will be allowed on major highways, thoroughfares or collector streets as shown on the "block party" map in the office of the Public Works Director.
11. Placement of the barricades will be as directed by the Public Works Director or his designee.
12. A deposit of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) will be required to ensure the return and condition of the barricades and cleanliness of the right-of-way area.
13. Any damages done to City property during the block party will be the responsibility of the applicant.
14. It is the responsibility of the applicant to advise the City prior to 2:00 p.m. on Friday (for weekend parties) if they intend to cancel. The applicant shall also notify the City at least three (3) days prior to the alternate date to arrange for delivery of the barricades.
